

## **12** Ways Mentoring Can Help Your Students

There are multiple ways mentoring can help your university or college support students by building relationships with peers, alumni and faculty. Mentoring software can help you manage programs that support these goals:

- 1. Introduce potential students to the university of college
- 2. Help new students get settled on campus in their first few weeks
- 3. Connect junior-level students with more senior-level students (Peer Mentoring)
- 4. Support diversity, equity and inclusion (DEI) on campus
- 5. Connect interns with employee mentors at Work Integrated Learning (WIL) programs
- 6. Enable "Quick Chat" meetings with alumni to answer quick questions
- 7. Half year or full year mentoring of graduating students by alumni
- 8. Connect new alumni with more senior alumni to learn about further career options
- 9. Provide mentors for campus-linked startup founders at incubators and accelerators
- 10. Match new faculty and admin staff with more senior faculty or staff
- 11. Add in-person mentoring meetings (or speed mentoring) at events
- 12. Provide mentoring across campus, per faculty and niche groups
